All about eco

Qambani has been created around sound eco and sustainable thinking.

We are growing vegetable, fruit and herb gardens, and our management are now running their own organic farm.

Electricity is supplied through a large bank of solar panels, and by the grid, for peak usage – with two private generator back-ups. All lighting is by super low wattage LED.

Our grey water is filtered through bio-rocks and recycled for use in the garden.

Sound

All rooms are connected to the latest audio sound technology – Sonos – whereby you can link to your personal music libraries via phone or internet (Spotify etc), mobile devices or live worldwide radio stations.

Wifi

All rooms are connected to wifi – the satellite internet supply in Zanzibar is usually adequate, but unlikely to achieve European down and upload speeds.

Electrical supply

All plugs are European Type E as pictured.

230V supply. Please bring appropriate adaptors. Supply is from the mains, with solar and double generator back-up.



Drinking water

Water is supplied from mains and collected during the rainy seasons. The supply is filtered thoroughly by carbon, UV and reverse osmosis, so all water from taps and ice-makers are of drinking water quality. Bottled drinking water also supplied.



Catering, Service & Management

Qambani can be rented on a full board or self-catering basis.

Full Board

Included:

All meals, on demand, with choices discussed daily with chef. Use of freshest local ingredients, including daily seafood.

Various cuisines available from bistro European to African, and Asian. Bottled water and hot drinks.

Not included: Soft drinks, spirits, cocktails, vintage wines and champagnes. Fine cuban cigars.

Self Catering

Arrangements can be made with management as required for provisioning of top quality fresh or dry produce, including local seafood, and wines and spirits.

Service

Qambani is fully staffed, including a manager, housekeepers, cook and driver. We like to arrange our schedules, menus and service totally around the guests' wishes. Prior to their arrival, Qambani will discuss guests' likely requirements - and respond accordingly.



Health and Security

Pre-holiday protection

Although cases of malaria in the Qambani region are non existing, Zanzibar is a malaria area.

Please note that under certain conditions, a yellow fever vaccination certificate is required on arrival in Zanzibar.

As Qambani is located close to the equator, good sun protection is strongly advised.

Please consult health professionals for further advice.

First aid/emergency

There is a full first aid kit at the house, and a number of members of staff have been trained in first aid.

Security

Qambani is a relatively low-risk area, but full precautions are taken to preserve guest privacy and safety. The perimeter of the whole property is walled – except for the coast side, which is protected by a low coral edge and thick bush. A private security firm ensures there are at least 10 guards on the property at any time.
